

Bible Verses All Sin Is Not The Same

- D) 1 John 5:16-17
- a) "If any one sees his brother committing what is not a mortal sin, he will ask, and God will give him life for those whose sin is not mortal. There is sin which is mortal; I do not say that one is to pray for that. **All wrongdoing is sin, but there is sin which is not mortal.**"
- II) John 19:11
- a) "Jesus answered him, "You would have no power over me unless it had been given you from above; therefore he who delivered me to you has the **greater sin.**"
- III) Mark 3:28-29
- a) "I tell you the truth, all the sins and blasphemies of men will be forgiven them. But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; he is guilty of an eternal sin."
- IV) Matthew 23:14
- a) "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense you make long prayers; **therefore you will receive greater condemnation.**"
- V) Hebrews 10:29
- a) "**How much more severely do you think a man deserves to be punished** who has trampled the Son of God under foot, who has treated as an unholy thing the blood of the covenant that sanctified him, and who has insulted the Spirit of grace?"
- VI) Hebrews 10:26
- a) "If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, **no sacrifice for sins is left.**"
- VII) Hebrews 6:4-6
- a) **It is impossible** for those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, who have shared in the Holy Spirit, who have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the coming age, if they fall away, **to be brought back to repentance**, because to their loss they are crucifying the Son of God all over again and subjecting him to public disgrace."
- VIII) Luke 12:47-48
- a) "That servant who knows his master's will and does not get ready or does not do what his master wants will be beaten **with many blows**. But the one who does not know and does things deserving punishment will be beaten **with few blows**. From everyone who has **been given much, much will be demanded**; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked."
- IX) James 3:1 "Not many of you should presume to be teachers, my brothers, because you know that we who teach **will be judged more strictly.**"
- X) Acts 17:30
- a) "In the past **God overlooked** such ignorance, **but now he commands all people everywhere to repent.**"
- XI) Lamentations 4:6
- a) "The **punishment of my people is greater than that of Sodom**, which was overthrown in a moment without a hand turned to help her."
- XII) Luke 17:1
- a) "Jesus said to his disciples: "Things that cause people to sin are **bound to come, but woe to that person through whom they come.**"
- XIII) Matthew 23:23

Bible Verses All Sin Is Not The Same

- a) “But you have neglected **the more important matters of the law--justice, mercy and faithfulness.**”
- XIV)** Matthew 22:36-38
- a) "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law? Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment."
- XV)** Matthew 5:19
- a) “Anyone who breaks one of the **least of these commandments** and teaches others to do the same will be called **least in the kingdom of heaven**, but whoever practices and teaches these commands will be called **great in the kingdom of heaven.**”
- i) My words, there is greater and lesser reward in heaven because of greater and lesser love. In the same way, there is greater and lesser punishment in hell because of greater and lesser sin.
- XVI)** John 15:13
- a) “**Greater love** has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends.”
- i) My words, if there is greater love, there is also greater sin.
- XVII)** 2 Peter 2:20-21
- a) “If they have escaped the corruption of the world by knowing our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and are again entangled in it and overcome, they are worse off at the end than they were at the beginning. It would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than to have known it and then to turn their backs on the sacred command that was passed on to them.”
- XVIII)** Deuteronomy 25:2-3
- a) “If the guilty man deserves to be beaten, the judge shall make him lie down and have him flogged in his presence **with the number of lashes his crime deserves**, but he must not give him more than forty lashes. If he is flogged more than that, your brother will be degraded in your eyes.”
- XIX)** Revelations 20:12
- a) “The dead were judged **according to what they had done** as recorded in the books.”
- XX)** 2 Corinthians 5:10
- a) “For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, **according to what he has done, whether good or bad.**”
- XXI)** Matthew 11:24
- a) “But I tell you that it will be **more bearable for Sodom** on the day of judgment **than for you.**”
