

- 1) In the Qur'an Allah repeatedly denies that Jesus is his son and repeatedly states that Allah has no son. In the Bible, God the Father repeatedly states that Jesus is His beloved son; therefore it is impossible for Allah and God the Father to be the same being/entity.
  - a) Matthew 3:17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am **well pleased**."
  - b) Matthew 17:5 "While he was still speaking, a bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am **well pleased**. Listen to him!"
  - c) Mark 1:11 "And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am **well pleased**."
  - d) Luke 3:22 "and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am **well pleased**."
- 2) Galatians 4:22-31
  - a) For it is written that Abraham had two sons, **one by a slave and one by a free woman. But the son of the slave was born according to the flesh, the son of the free woman through promise. Now this is an allegory:** these women are two covenants. One is from **Mount Sinai, bearing children for slavery; she is Hagar. Now Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia;** she corresponds to the present Jerusalem, for **she is in slavery with her children. But the Jerusalem above is free, and she is our mother.** For it is written, "Rejoice, O barren one who does not bear; break forth and shout, you who are not in travail; **for the children of the desolate one are many more than the children of her that is married.**" Now we, brethren, like Isaac, are children of promise. But as at that time he who was **born according to the flesh** persecuted him who was **born according to the Spirit, so it is now.** But what does the scripture say? **"Cast out the slave and her son; for the son of the slave shall not inherit with the son of the free woman."** So, **brethren, we are not children of the slave but of the free woman.**
    - i) Hagar is represented by Mount Sinai in Arabia. Sarah is represented by Mount Moria the Temple Mount in Jerusalem.
    - ii) Hagar leads to the bondage, slavery and the death of sin and the law. Sarah leads to the promise of freedom from sin and eternal life.
    - iii) Hagar and Ishmael were born according to the flesh. Sarah and Isaac were born according to the Holy Spirit.
    - iv) Ishmael persecuted Isaac and Esau persecuted Jacob. So to do the Muslims persecute the Jews and Christians.
  - b) Genesis 22:2 He said, "Take your son, **your only son Isaac**
    - i) **Ishmael is not listed as a son, but only Isaac**
  - c) **Ishmael was the slave son to Abraham. Isaac was regarded by God as the true son of the free woman Sarah. To this very day all Muslims view Allah as the Master and all of mankind as slaves to Allah. Jesus said that we are no longer servants (slaves)**

**to God, but we are now sons and daughters to God the Father. John 15:15, John 8:35, and Galatians 4:4-8.**

3) Genesis 17:10-14

a) " This is my covenant with you and your descendants after you, the covenant you are to keep: **Every male among you shall be circumcised. You are to undergo circumcision, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and you. For the generations to come every male among you who is eight days old must be circumcised**, including those born in your household or bought with money from a foreigner--those who are not your offspring. **Whether born in your household or bought with your money, they must be circumcised. My covenant in your flesh is to be an everlasting covenant. Any uncircumcised male, who has not been circumcised in the flesh, will be cut off from his people; he has broken my covenant."**

i) **Isaac was circumcised on the 8th day. Genesis 21:4 "When his son Isaac was eight days old, Abraham circumcised him, as God commanded him." Ishmael was not circumcised on the 8th day and because of this Ishmael and all of his descendants (Muslims) have been cut off and broken God's covenant. To this very day all Jewish male infants are circumcised on the 8th day.**

4) Genesis 17:24-25 "Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he was circumcised, and **his son Ishmael was thirteen**".

a) **To this very day all Muslim male boys are circumcised in their thirteenth year.**

5) Genesis 17:19-21

a) " Then God said, "Yes, but your **wife Sarah will bear you a son**, and you will call him **Isaac. I will establish my covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his descendants after him.** And as for Ishmael, I have heard you: I will surely bless him; I will make him fruitful and will greatly increase his numbers. **He will be the father of twelve rulers**, and I will make him into a great nation. **But my covenant I will establish with Isaac, whom Sarah will bear to you by this time next year.**"

b) **Notice that God says the covenant is only with the son Isaac and his descendants. Ishmael and his descendants ARE NOT PART OF THIS COVENANT!**

c) **Who are the twelve rulers that God refers to in verse 20? The 12 rulers are the 12 Imams (descendants of Muhammad and Ishmael) of the Islamic religion. The 12th Imam (Grand Mahdi) is the antichrist. These twelve Imams and rulers are clearly understood and believed by Muslims. This teaching of Islam is explained at the following link:**

6) Genesis 21:9-12, 14

a) "But Sarah saw that the son whom Hagar the Egyptian had borne to Abraham was **mocking**, and she said to Abraham, "**Get rid of that slave woman and her son, for that slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with my son Isaac.** The matter distressed Abraham greatly because it concerned his son. But **God said to him, "Do not**

**be so distressed about the boy and your maidservant. Listen to whatever Sarah tells you, because it is through Isaac that your offspring will be reckoned.** Early the next morning Abraham took some food and a skin of water and gave them to Hagar. He set them on her shoulders and **then sent her off with the boy. She went on her way and wandered in the desert of Beersheba.**"

- b) Notice that Ishmael is not to share the inheritance with Isaac. Also notice that despite Abraham being distressed God tells Abraham to do what Sarah said and send Ishmael away into the desert because it is only through Isaac that Abraham's offspring will be reckoned. We know that only through Jesus Christ, an offspring of Abraham and Isaac, has the world been reckoned and redeemed.

7) John 8:35

- a) " Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever."  
b) Dr. Scott Hahn states that Jesus is implying, "that Ishmael is disinherited to make room for Isaac, the true son".

9) 1 John 2:22

- a) Who is the liar? **Whoever denies that Jesus is the Christ. Whoever denies the Father and the Son, this is the antichrist. No one who denies the Son has the Father.**  
i) **Muslims deny that Jesus is the Christ and they deny that Jesus is the son of God, so not only do Muslims not have Jesus, but they also do not have the Father.**

10) Galatians 1:8

- a) But even if we or an **angel from heaven** should preach (to you) a gospel other than the one that we preached to you, let that one be accursed!  
i) Muslims believe the angel Gabriel preached another Gospel (Qur'an) to Muhammad. It was not Gabriel, but another fallen angel.

11) James 2:19

- a) You believe that God is one. You do well. Even the demons believe that and tremble.  
i) Muslims do not believe in the Trinity, but only in one god and one nature alone, Allah, but that in itself and by itself is not sufficient.

12) Daniel 7:25

- a) He will speak against the Most High and oppress his saints and try to change the **set times and the laws.**  
i) This speaks of Muslims and the antichrist that will try to change to the **Islamic Lunar Calendar** and to **Sharia Law.**

13) Revelations 20:4

a) Also I saw the souls of those who had been **beheaded for their testimony to Jesus** and for the word of God, and who **had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark** on their foreheads or their hands.

i) Do you know of any other religion or organization anywhere in the world that repeatedly and habitually beheads people; other than Muslims?

14) John 16:2

a) “a time is coming when anyone who kills you will think he is **offering a service to God.**”

i) This necessitates not only a belief in God, but also some form of religious system whereby the mentality that killing in the name of God is not only reasonable, but actually good. This religious system is Islam. Atheists and communists don't believe in God; therefore, the antichrist's kingdom cannot be a secular, communistic, or atheistic kingdom, nation or system.

15) Kingdoms of the antichrist-all of these are Muslim nations:

a) Ezekiel 30:5 Cush and Put, Lydia and all Arabia, Libya and the people of the covenant land will fall by the sword along with Egypt.

b) Ezekiel 38:2,5-6

i) "Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal; prophesy against him. Persia, Cush and Put will be with them, all with shields and helmets, also Gomer with all its troops, and Beth Togarmah.

16) The Islamic Antichrist By: Joel Richardson Chapter 18

A SUMMARY OF COMPARISONS BETWEEN THE ISLAMIC AND BIBLICAL NARRATIVES OF THE END TIMES

a) Bible: The Antichrist is an unparalleled political, military, and religious leader that will emerge in the last days.

Islam: The Mahdi is an unparalleled political, military, and religious leader that will emerge in the last days.

b) Bible: The False Prophet is a secondary prominent figure that will emerge in the last days who will support the Antichrist.

Islam: The Muslim Jesus is a secondary prominent figure that will emerge in the last days to support the Mahdi.

c) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet together will have a powerful army that will do great damage to the earth in an effort to subdue every nation and dominate the world.

Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus will have a powerful army that will attempt to control every nation of the earth and dominate the world.

d) Bible: The False Prophet is described essentially as a dragon in lamb's clothing.

Islam: The Muslim Jesus comes bearing the name of the one that the world knows as "the Lamb of God," Jesus Christ. Yet the Muslim Jesus comes to murder all those who do not submit to Islam.

e) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet establish a new world order.  
Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus establish a new world order.

f) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet institute new laws for the whole earth.  
Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus Institute Islamic law all over the earth.

g) Bible: The Antichrist is said to "change the times.

"Islam: It is quite certain that if the Mahdi established Islam all over the earth, he would discontinue the use of Saturday and Sunday as the weekend or days of rest, changing to Friday, the holy day of Islam. Also, he would most certainly eliminate the Gregorian calendar and replace it with the Islamic calendar currently used in every Islamic country.

h) Bible: The Antichrist and False Prophet will both be powerful religious leaders who will attempt to institute a universal world religion.

Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus will institute Islam as the only religion on the earth.

i) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet will execute anyone who does not submit to their world religion.

Islam: Likewise, the Mahdi and Muslim Jesus will execute anyone who does not submit to Islam.

j) Bible: The Antichrist and False Prophet will specifically use beheading as the primary means of execution for nonconformists.  
Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus will use the Islamic practice of beheading for executions.

k) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet will have a specific agenda to kill as many Jews as possible.  
Islam: The Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus will kill as many Jews as possible, until only a few are left hiding behind rocks and trees.

l) Bible: The Antichrist and the False Prophet will attack to conquer and seize Jerusalem.  
Islam: The Mahdi and Muslim Jesus will attack to re-conquer and seize Jerusalem for Islam.

m) Bible: The Antichrist will set himself up in Jerusalem on the Temple Mount and make it the seat of his authority.  
Islam: The Mahdi will establish the Islamic caliphate from Jerusalem.

- n) Bible: The False Prophet is said to do many miracles to deceive as many as possible into supporting the Antichrist.

Islam: The Mahdi himself is said to control the weather and crops. His face is said to glow. We can also assume that since Jesus is viewed as having been empowered by Allah to work miracles when He was here on earth the first time, He will most likely be expected to continue to do so when He returns.

- o) Bible: The Antichrist is described as riding on a white horse in the Book of Revelation.  
Islam: The Mahdi is described as riding on a white horse (ironically in the same verse).

- p) Bible: The Antichrist is said to make a peace treaty with Israel for seven years.  
Islam: The Mahdi is said to make a peace treaty through a Jew (specifically a Levite) for exactly seven years.

- q) Bible: Jesus the Jewish Messiah will return to defend the Jews in Israel from a military attack from a vast coalition of nations led by the Antichrist and the False Prophet.

Islam: The Dajjal, the Islamic Antichrist, will gain a great Jewish following and claim to be Jesus Christ; he will fight against the Mahdi and the Muslim Jesus.

- r) Bible: The spirit of antichrist specifically denies the most unique and central doctrines of Christianity, namely the Trinity, the incarnation, and the substitutionary death of Jesus on the Cross.

Islam: Islam doctrinally and spiritually specifically denies the most unique and central doctrines of Christianity, namely the Trinity, the incarnation, and the substitutionary death of Jesus on the Cross.

- s) Bible: The primary warning of Jesus and the Apostle Paul was to warn Christians of the abundance of deceit and deception in the last days.

Islam: Islam is perhaps the only religion on earth that practices deceit as one of its tools to assist its own ascendancy. It actually has a specific doctrine that allows and even calls for deception to be used to achieve its desired end.

- t) Bible: The specific nations pictured in the Bible as part of the final empire of the Antichrist are all Islamic nations.

Islam: All Muslims are commanded to give their allegiance to the Mahdi as the final caliph and imam (leader) of Islam.

- u) Bible: From the Bible and history we learn that the final Antichrist empire will be a revived version of the empire that succeeds the Roman empire.

Islam: The empire that succeeded the Roman/Byzantine empire was the Islamic Ottoman empire.

- v) Bible: When the Antichrist emerges, a system will already exist that is poised to receive him as savior and to give allegiance to him.

Islam: Islam is already the second-largest religion and will at present growth rates become the largest religion within a few decades. Islam awaits the coming of the Mahdi with universal anticipation.
