

## Contraception is a Sin

- 1) Genesis 1:28 “God blessed them and said to them, "**Be fruitful and increase in number**; fill the earth and subdue it.”
- 2) Genesis 9:1 “Then God blessed Noah and his sons, saying to them, "Be **fruitful** and **increase in number** and fill the earth.”
- 3) Genesis 9:7 “As for you, **be fruitful and increase in number; multiply** on the earth and **increase** upon it.”
- 4) Luke 23:29 “For the time will come when you will say, 'Blessed are the **barren women, the wombs that never bore** and the breasts that **never nursed!**'”
  - a) Three times God commands that mankind reproduce, multiply and fill the earth. This is not a suggestion or request. This is a command by God Himself. Contraception by any means clearly gravely disobeys and contradicts this command of God. The fourth verse is a clear and direct prophecy by Jesus Christ that one day mankind will hate bearing children and will instead consider never having children to be a blessing. - 5) Genesis 38:8-10 "Then Judah said to Onan, "Lie with your brother's wife and fulfill your duty to her as a brother-in-law to produce offspring for your brother." "But Onan knew that the offspring would not be his; so whenever he lay with his brother's wife, he spilled his semen on the ground **to keep from producing offspring for his brother**. What he did was wicked in the LORD's sight; so he put him to death also."
  - a) Here we clearly see that contraception is a sin in God's eyes. The entire purpose that Onan spilled his seed on the ground was to avoid producing offspring. Nothing could be more clear than this verse will directly prove that contraception is a sin and angers God.
