## Holy Water is JUST BLESSED WATER!

- 1) 2 Kings 13:21: And as a man was being buried, lo, a marauding band was seen and the man was cast into the grave of Elisha; and as soon as the man touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood on his feet.
- 2) Acts 19:11 -12: And God did extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, so that handkerchiefs or aprons were carried away from his body to the sick, and diseases left them and the evil spirits came out of them.
- 3) Matthew 14: 35-36: And when the men of that place recognized him, they sent round to all that region and brought to him all that were sick, and besought him that they might only touch the fringe of his garment; and as many as touched it were made well.
- 4) Matthew 10:12-13
  - a) As you enter the house, salute it. And if the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it; but if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. Or
  - b) As you enter the home, give it your greeting. If the home is deserving, let your peace rest on it; if it is not, let your peace return to you.
- 5) Numbers 5:17:
  - a) and the priest shall take **holy water** in an earthen vessel, and take some of the dust that is on the floor of the tabernacle and put it into the water.\
- 6) Exodus 3:5
  - a) "Do not come any closer," God said. "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is **holy ground**."
- 7) Genesis 1:21-22
  - a) "So God created the great creatures of the sea and every living thing with which the water teems and that moves about in it, according to their kinds, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. God blessed them and said, "Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the water in the seas, and let the birds increase on the earth."
- 8) Genesis 27:27
  - a) "Ah, the smell of my son is like the smell of a field that the LORD has **blessed**."
- 9) Deuteronomy 28:4 "The fruit of your womb will be **blessed**, and the crops of your land and the young of your livestock--the calves of your herds and the lambs of your flocks."
- 10) Deuteronomy 28:5 " Your basket and your kneading trough will be **blessed**."
